A Resolution of the Council of the City of Lompoc,

Approving and Adopting the Tentative Agreement and
Memorandum of Understanding Between the City of Lompoc and the
Lompoc Police Officers' Association for the period
July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022 and Amending the City's
Compensation Plan/Pay Plan (Rule IV) Authorizing Salary Adjustments For
Specified Lompoc Police Officers' Association Classifications

- WHEREAS, the City of Lompoc (City) has formally recognized the Lompoc Police Officers' Association (LPOA) as the exclusive employee organization for the police bargaining unit: and
- **WHEREAS**, the current Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City and LPOA effective from July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021, expired on June 30, 2021; and
- WHEREAS, the City and LPOA have successfully met and conferred to negotiate a new LPOA MOU for the period of July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022 (LPOA MOU 2021-2022), pursuant to the Meyers-Millias-Brown Act (Brown Act) (Government Code sections 3500-3511) and Resolution No. 2041(70) pertaining to employer-employee relations; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City's labor representatives and LPOA representatives executed a written Tentative Agreement on July 13, 2021, for a successor LPOA MOU 2021-2022, which Tentative Agreement was ratified by LPOA on July 12, 2021; and
- **WHEREAS,** upon City Council adoption of the Tentative Agreement, the parties are required to jointly prepare a written MOU, which the City and LPOA have already concurrently prepared, the LPOA MOU 2021-2022, and hereby present to City Council for concurrent approval with the Tentative Agreement; and
- **WHEREAS**, upon City Council approval, the successor LPOA MOU 2021-2022 becomes a binding agreement between the two parties; and
- **WHEREAS**, upon City Council approval of the LPOA MOU 2021-2022, the salary and benefit changes outlined therein shall be incorporated into the adopted Biennial Budget Fiscal Years 2021-2023 (Budget); and;
- **WHEREAS,** Rule IV, Section 1 and 2 of the Personnel Rules of the City provide for the adoption, amendment, and revision of the Citywide Compensation Plan to reflect changes thereto; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council desires to approve the Tentative Agreement and the LPOA MOU 2021-2022, and desires to amend the Compensation Plan as required by the terms of the LPOA MOU 2021-2022; and

WHEREAS, the City Council also desires to, and provides funding for, the impacts of the terms of the LPOA MOU 2021-2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council approves the Tentative Agreement entered into July 13, 2021, and ratified by LPOA, for a successor LPOA MOU 2021-2022 for the period of July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022, a fully executed copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and by this reference is made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. The City Council approves the successor LPOA MOU 2021-2022 for the period of July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022, a fully executed copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit B and by this reference is made a part hereof.

SECTION 3. The City Council amends and revises the city-wide Pay/Compensation Plan pursuant to and in accordance with the salary tables and classification titles listed in the Attachments to the LPOA MOU 2021-2022 effective July 17, 2021, through June 30, 2022, as outlined in Exhibit C attached hereto.

SECTION 4. The City Council approves supplemental appropriations to fund the Budget due to the changes in the Budget resulting from the LPOA MOU 2021-2022 as outlined in Exhibit D attached hereto.

SECTION 5. The City Council approves supplemental appropriations as follows:
