As previously agreed to by the Lompoc Artificial Kidney Center, the rescheduled hearing date of May 18, 2021, at 6:30 pm or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the City Council Chamber at City Hall, 100 Civic Center Plaza, Lompoc, California, has been set to conduct the continued hearing of your appeals ("Appeals") of the Utility Director's June 27, 2019 ruling and March 30, 2021, rulings, both regarding Wastewater Discharge Permit I-0013.

Also, as previously agreed, if LAKC timely met the below criteria, then the hearing for the Appeals will be rescheduled for June 15, 2021:

- Provide a definitive timeline for installation of the upgraded water softener, including performance specifications.
  - Copy of contract must be provided.
  - Timeline due to City no later than May 11, 2021.
- Provide a definitive timeline for installation of a representative sample point that provides 24-hour access for city personnel.
  - Must include a flow meter.
  - Timeline due to City no later than May 11, 2021.

This letter is being sent at this time to meet the 10-day notice requirement set forth in Lompoc Municipal Code subdivision 1.32.060 B.
