

RESOLUTION NO. 6454(21)

**A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lompoc,
County of Santa Barbara, State of California,
Approving Supplemental Appropriations for the
Acquisition of a Solid Waste Landfill (High Lift) Loader
Vehicle and Awarding the Purchase Order Contract to
The Quinn Company**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lompoc (City) adopted Resolution No. 6299(20) on January 21, 2020, approving lease financing for the appropriation of a landfill compactor; and

WHEREAS, the acquisition of a Caterpillar Loader (Loader) model 930 M replaces the existing 2004 Loader model IT28G which has exceeded its operational life and is in need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, the bid received from Quinn Company was the highest qualifying bid meeting the requirements of Request for Proposal No. 2965; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to complete the purchase of the replacement Compactor from Quinn Company and to appropriate funds for the completion of the purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The award of a purchase order contract for the Compactor is made to the Quinn Company based on the criteria outlined in the Request for Proposal No 2965.

SECTION 2. Budget appropriations are for the purchase of the replacement (High Lift) Loader approved at the October 5, 2021, City Council meeting and related revenue or reserves are approved as follows:

SECTION 3. The carryover Loader (Unit 7180) currently used as a backup to the 2004 Loader shall be deemed surplus and disposed of utilizing the Purchasing Division's surplus property procedures. The current Loader (Unit 11) will be categorized as a carryover unit to be the alternate unit at times when the new Loader is being serviced or is otherwise out of service.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution is effective on the day of its adoption. The supplemental appropriations are effective for the respective fiscal years indicated in Section 2 above.
