

RESOLUTION NO. 6476(22)

**A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lompoc,
County of Santa Barbara, State of California,
Revising the Method for Filling Vacancies on the Public Safety
Commission and Human Services Commission**

WHEREAS, the City Council previously revised the appointment method and qualifications for members of the Public Safety Commission and Human Services Commission to create a by-district appointment structure; and

WHEREAS, under the current structure, commissioners must reside in the district of the Council Member who appoints them; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend the procedure for filling commission vacancies to allow a Councilmember to appoint a commissioner from outside of the Council Member's district, in some circumstances.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council approves the Handbook dated March 18, 2022, attached hereto as Exhibit A, which supersedes each and every previously adopted Handbook, and supersedes all previously adopted City Council resolutions, to the extent that such resolutions are in conflict with, or are inconsistent with, the Handbook.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the effective date of Ordinance No. 1688(22).
