SUBJECT: Approval of Response to the 2021 Santa Barbara County Grand Jury

Report - Lompoc Police Department, "Moving Toward a Safe and Proud

Community"

Recommendation:

Staff recommends the City Council review the 2021 Santa Barbara County Grand Jury (Grand Jury) report entitled Lompoc Police Department, "Moving Toward a Safe and Proud Community" (Attachment 1) and approve the proposed response letter presented on behalf of the City, pursuant to California Penal Code Sections 933(c) and 933.05(a), (b) and (c) (Attachment 2).

Background:

Each year, the Grand Jury surveys various operations involving governmental services provided for the benefit of the residents of the County of Santa Barbara (County). The 2021 Grand Jury selected the Lompoc Police Department as an area of focus. The 2021 Grand Jury provided a report with recommendations for the City of Lompoc and the Police Department.

The City received the 2021 Grand Jury report Lompoc Police Department "Moving Toward a Safe and Proud Community on December 16, 2021. All jurisdictions noticed in the Grand Jury Report must file a response to the findings and recommendations pursuant to the above referenced California Penal Code sections within 90 days of its receipt, or no later than March 26, 2022. The Grand Jury report on the Lompoc Police Department contained two findings and two recommendations for the City and the Police Department. The City is required to respond to the stated findings and recommendations, listed on pages 7-8 of the Grand Jury report.
