SUBJECT: Purchase of Security Equipment for Transit Operations/Fleet Maintenance Facility

Recommendation:

Staff recommends the City Council approve the award of a purchase order with SecurePro for security equipment for the Transit Operations/Fleet Maintenance Facility for an amount not to exceed \$426,602.

Background/Discussion:

Staff has secured funding in the amount of \$426,602 from Proposition 1B, California Transit Security Grant Program (CTSGP) funds, for security improvements for the Transit Operations/Fleet Maintenance Facility to be located at 320 N. "D" Street. The Transit Operations/Fleet Maintenance Facility Project is in the final design phase and the CTSGP funding grant must be closed out before April 1, 2022.

For the past two years, the City has been working to upgrade and integrate its facility security systems with SecurePro equipment and service agreements. Prior to using SecurePro, the City experienced frequent problems with multiple other security system service providers including systems not working correctly despite many repeated service calls, hardware not being compatible with software, very delayed response times for service calls, and expensive service call charges. SecurePro hardware and software has functioned very well for the City, and service calls have been consistently prompt and effective. Since beginning to use SecurePro and benefit from its highly functional security systems and adept service, the City has progressively upgraded its systems to SecurePro, which now covers a number of City facilities.

Acquiring the SecurePro equipment for this project now with the grant funds will ensure the City receives proven highly functional equipment which is consistent with the City's current standard facility security systems. Additionally, SecurePro equipment is compatible with the City's current standard facility security software and service agreements, and allows the new Transit Operations/Fleet Maintenance Facility site to be effectively tied into the City's broader facility security network.

This award has been reviewed and recommended by Ray Ambler, Purchasing and Materials Manager, and Dirk Ishiwata, Fleet and Facilities Manager. This award is justified by Lompoc

Municipal Code Section 10.36.040.E. "Standardization." Staff expects the Transit Operations/Fleet Maintenance Facility Project to be constructed in 2023.

Fiscal Impact:

All funds, for this purchase, are provided by State Proposition 1B Security grants and have already been deposited in a City account. There is no impact to the City General Fund.

Conclusion:

Approving the award of the purchase order with SecurePro will allow the City to utilize its grant funding for security equipment for the Transit Operations/Fleet Maintenance Facility Project.
