 - To be paid with future funds:
 General Fund surplus or
 Capital Development Funds







- STATION #1 EXHAUSTREMOVAL SYSTEM
 - \$105k total
 - Paid with FY22 Gen Fund budget







STATION #1 BATHROOMS

- \$54k total
- Paid with FY22 Gen Fund budget







POLICE VEHICLES

- 8 New Patrol Vehicles
- 1 New Patrol Motorcycle
- 1 New SWAT Vehicle
- \$396k Total
 - \$390k Paid with FY22 GF budget
 - \$6k to be proposed from GF
 FY22 surplus




















PARKS & RECREATION

Capital Development Fund Outlays – 2022 to date




- Public Safety Police & Fire

Capital Development Fund Outlays – Remaining




- 75% of Capital Outlays since May21 have been Public Safety
- Parks & Rec since May21 = 24%

\$889k Remaining Staff recommendation to assign remaining 424CIP to Parks & Recreation Capital Improvements

OVERWHELMING SUPPORT FOR PUBLIC SAFETY AND PARKS & RECREATION CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS




FORESIGHT OF CITY COUNCIL

EVEN BEFORE 21-23 BUDGET CYCLE COMPLETED, COUNCIL APPROVED LARGE PUBLIC SAFETY INFRASTRUCTURE OUTLAYS



FUNDS SET ASIDE FOR CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENTS – ONE TIME IN
NATURE AND EXPECTED TO
ADDRESS BOTH STRATEGY,
PRIORITY, AND URGENCY



LOOKING AHEAD

FUTURE GENERAL FUND
SURPLUS WILL BE AVAILABLE
TO ADDRESS NEXT TIER OF
PRIORITIES IN YEARS TO COME
