Lompoc Aquatic Center



Background

- Lompoc Aquatic Center (LAC) opened in 2006
- Operates year-round 7 days a week
- Offers programming, such as:
 - Swim Lessons (Youth and Adult)
 - Water Exercise classes
 - Safety training (Lifeguard & Swim Instructor)
 - Recreational swim
 - Lap swimming
 - Sporting & community events
 - Facility rental opportunities
- The LAC serves approx. 120,000 youth, adults, and seniors annually









Background





- Much of the existing equipment at the LAC is original (16-years old)
- Key operational equipment is beginning to breakdown and fail
- Additionally, this equipment has far exceeded its lifespan
- Staff recommends the City Council adopt Resolution No. 6482(22) (attached) authorizing the supplemental appropriations of \$983,288 for the Aquatic Center Roof Repair, Pool Heaters and Dehumidification System Replacement Project



Dehumidification System

- Installed in 2011
- 10-year lifespan
- Maintenance and repairs for each unit (4) has increased each year due to failing parts
- Risk of damage to the LAC's infrastructure due to corrosive air
- Estimated replacement cost - \$610, 816

Ceiling Panels

- 44 retractable ceiling panels
- 10-year lifespan of parts
- Replacement of the retractable ceiling panels' motors, tracks, and weather stripping should have occurred in 2016
- 8 panels have been repaired to-date
- Estimated replacement cost of 36 remaining panels -\$216,612

Activity Pool Ceiling Panels

- Estimated replacement cost of 36 remaining panels replaced individually at \$12,000 each - \$216,612
- The LAC was one of the few recreation facilities to not shut down during the pandemic due the ceiling panels being able to open



Pool Heaters



Current Competition Pool Heater





- 6-8 year lifespan (Depends on water quality & constant maintenance)
- Original heaters almost 16 years old
- Activity pool heater was replaced in 2021
- If the remaining competition pool & therapy pool heaters were to fail – the pool(s) could be closed from 4-6 months





Pool Heaters

- New energy efficient heaters will save money on gas and electricity
- Estimated replacement cost of the remaining two pool heaters
 \$155,860

Fiscal Impact



- Historically the City has not had sufficient revenue sources in the General Fund to fund reserves for the LAC capital replacements
- No funds are specifically set aside to replace these equipment components which have a finite lifespan
- Supplemental appropriations are identified in Resolution No. 6482(22) to fund the remaining amount required for the improvements of \$983,288 from 424CIP "Govt. Capital Improvements"





Closing

- The LAC is a valuable asset for all members of our community to enjoy throughout the year.
- Completing the work items as described above—
 - Demonstrates a proactive approach in our City Recreational Facility
 Maintenance
 - Delivers a quality product that our City residents demand and deserve
