

**RESOLUTION NO. 6495(22)**

**A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lompoc,  
County of Santa Barbara, State of California,  
Approving Supplemental Appropriations and Supplemental  
Revenues for Ryon Park Tennis and Pickle Ball Court,  
Lompoc Parks and Recreation Facilities Master Plan,  
and JM Ball Park Restroom / Concession Stand Projects**

**WHEREAS**, on April 5, 2022, the City Council of the City of Lompoc (City) directed staff to identify capital projects to utilize \$889,000 in surplus Capital Development Funds, and

**WHEREAS**, on April 12, 2022, the Parks and Recreation Commission received public comment and agreed to the following recommendation for project funding: 1) Ryon Park Tennis and Pickle Ball Court (\$650,000); 2) Lompoc Master Parks and Recreation Facilities Project (\$150,000); and 3) recommended staff identify the best usage of the remaining balance of \$89,000; and

**WHEREAS**, staff reviewed funding appropriated to the JM Ball Park Restroom / Concession Stand project and recommend appropriating the \$89,000 balance of funding to that project to ensure there is sufficient funding to address any infrastructure or other needs that may arise on that project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to complete the Ryon Park Tennis and Pickle Ball Court, Lompoc Master Parks and Recreation Facilities Plan, and JM Ball Park Restroom / Concession Stand projects.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** To approve budget appropriations for the Projects as follows:
