STAFF REPORT
April 2022

YOUTH SPORTS- Youth Tennis Lessons had 4 participants, Youth Evolution Soccer had 33 participants for the month of April. There are 132 children signed up for Junior Giants thus far. The track Meet on April 24th was attended by around 200 athletes.

YOUTH & TEEN PROGRAMS- Karate Tang Soo Do was offered the month of April with a total of 28 participants, Kendo had 4 participants. An Easter Egg Deco Workshop was offered and had 10 registrants. Our annual Summer Teen Employment Workshop was held this year during Spring Break. A total of 18 teens attended and interview for potential employment with Parks & Recreation.

ADULT CLASSES- There were eight participants registered for Dance Fitness, four participants for Stretch and Relax and 13 participants for Adult Dance for the month of April.

ADULT SPORTS- There are 10 teams registered in the Coed Softball and nine teams in Men's. We had 28 participants for Drop-in Volleyball.

LOMPOC OUTDOOR COMMUNITY MARKET- 227 spaces were reserved for the month of March.

SPECIAL EVENTS – The return of the annual Lompoc Kiwanis and Parks & Recreation Easter Egg Hunt was back on this year at River Park on Saturday, April 16th. The event included a bounce house, free face painting courtesy of MOMS Club, a nominal fee snack bar, a food truck and egg hunts every 15-minutes. There was also a photo opportunity provided with the Easter Bunny.

The Lompoc Kiwanis and Parks & Recreation's Golf Tournament held on Friday, April 29th was a success, with 57 participants.

FACILITY RENTALS –The Anderson Recreation Center had two rentals including the Lompoc High School Spring Fundraiser, nine sports rentals, a Church rental that met 11 times; Dick DeWees Community and Senior Center had seven rentals including the Cabrillo High Prom and State of the City, and one Church rental that met 11 times; 26 Park rentals. Lompoc Little League, Babe Ruth and Lompoc Girls Softball continued to use the sports fields for their games and practices.

MISCELLANEOUS PROGRAMS- There were 263 passports that were processed at the Anderson Recreation Center this month and 170 Passport Photos processed.
