- Appliances (max 2 per day)
- Mattresses & Box Springs
- Tires (max 5 per day)
- Batteries
- Carpet & Padding (rolled)
- Cardboard (clean/flattened)
- Electronic Waste
- Asphalt
- Clean topsoil

\*Items accepted for a fee:

- Couches/furniture
- Treated/painted wood
- Scrap metal
- General refuse/trash

#### **Recycle Right!**

**EMPTY - NO** food residue

**DRY - NO** liquids

**LOOSE - NO** bags; do not bag your recyclables.

### **Christmas Eve**

**Tuesday, December 24th**

Regular collection day. The Landfill will operate under its **alternate schedule** of 10AM - 3:45PM.

### **Christmas Day**

**Wednesday, December 25th**

Trash Collection will be **delayed by 1 day** the rest of the week. The Landfill **will be closed**.

### **New Year's Day**

**Wednesday, January 1**

Trash Collection will be **delayed by 1 day** the rest of the week. The Landfill **will be closed**.

The Solid Waste Office and Household Hazardous Waste Facility will be **closed** on all listed holidays.

## Prepping for the holidays?

Don't trash unused leftovers! In fact, over the holidays, Americans waste 25% more food than during the rest of the year. Millions of pounds of uneaten turkey, gravy, green beans, mashed potatoes and other seasonal trimmings unfortunately end up in landfills. Food is the single largest category of material placed in landfills! All of your food scraps and leftovers can be put in your green lidded organics cart to be composted and turned into a high-quality soil amendment. When food decomposes in a landfill, methane gas is produced. Reduce greenhouse gas emissions by making sure you are not causing more waste this season!

### **Holiday Pro Tips for Less Waste**

- Freeze your leftovers so you can dispose of the solid material (no bag) in your bin the night before service day!
- Don't overestimate the amount of food to cook.
- Recycle or compost your leftovers.
- Share leftovers not only with family and friends but also with those in need.
- Reusable is better than disposable.
