

RESOLUTION NO. 6203(18)

A Resolution of the Council of the City of Lompoc, County of Santa Barbara, State of California, Suspending the July 1, 2018, Final Increase in the Solid Waste Service Charges and Fees

WHEREAS, on June 3, 2014, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 5920(14) establishing fees and charges for the City's Solid Waste Services; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of July 17, 2018, after considering the then current reserves in the Solid Waste Enterprise Fund and impacts the 3.6% increase in solid waste service charges established by Resolution No. 5920(14) would have on many rate payers, the City Council decided to suspend the final 3.6% increase, leaving those charges at the same levels as effective on June 30, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Effective as of July 1, 2018, the City Council hereby suspends collection of the July 1, 2018, 3.6% increase in solid waste service charges to the City of Lompoc's solid waste service customers.

SECTION 2: Based on the above, the tables with the effective dates of 7/1/2018, as set forth in Exhibits 1, 2, 3 and 5 of Resolution No. 5920(14) are hereby amended to be the same as the tables in those same exhibits with the effective date 7/1/2017.

SECTION 3: The City Council reserves the authority to rescind the suspensions established hereunder at any time it determines necessary.

SECTION 4: Except as expressly provided herein, all the terms and provisions of Resolution No. 5859(13) remain in full force and effect.
