A Resolution of the Council of the City of Lompoc, County of Santa Barbara, State of California, Adopting the Supplemental Appropriations for the Ryon Park Pavement Improvement Project (Project No. FY-18-P-1)

WHEREAS, the City has developed Project No. FY-18-P-1, Ryon Park Pavement Improvement Project (Project), in conjunction with Project No. FY-18-S-3, to restore the pavement surface of the parking lot at Ryon Park; and

WHEREAS, the Project construction work at Ryon Park, along with engineering and construction management for the Project, is proposed to be funded with \$12,500 of supplemental appropriations from a portion of accumulated park rental revenues restricted to the use of park maintenance in the Park Lease Maintenance Program resources, and with \$63,500 previously appropriated from the Park Improvement Development Impact Fee Program resources; and

WHEREAS, the Project has now been bid and requires total appropriations of \$76,000 which has been established as the Project's estimated budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to appropriate \$12,500 for the construction and completion of the Project anticipated to be expended during the current Fiscal Year (FY) 2018-19.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council authorizes the supplemental appropriation of funds from unrestricted, unobligated fund balance resources for the Project as follows:
