Please accept this as a Written Communication and Public Comment for Item #11 "Revisions to Policy Regarding Anonymous Code Enforcement Complaints and Public Disclosure of the Names of Persons Making Code Enforcement Complaints".

I would suggest you consider the following changes:

- 1. Create an electronic method to notify persons reporting alleged code enforcement issues that their complaint has been received. For example you could assign a case number (example for first case of 2022: 22-0001) then inform complainant that the complaint had been received and provide the case number. Then refer them to a case number log with actions taken that would be posted on the City website. Each time the code enforcement officer took action on the case he/she could update the log to reflect the action taken. For example:
  - Acknowledge receipt of complaint.
  - Notify when site visit completed.
  - Was complaint valid or invalid (if invalid state why); and,
  - Provide periodic status reports when abatement actions are appropriate (when begun and when completed and when case is closed).
- 2. Change the policy to allow anonymous complaints.
- 3. Maintain an appeal process for alleged violators. The City Attorney, Community Development Director or City Manager would be the final arbiter since code enforcement is a technical and not a political issue.
