

**RESOLUTION NO. 6547(22)**

**A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lompoc,  
County of Santa Barbara, State of California,  
Authorizing Application for Regional Climate  
Collaborative Grant Program and Participation in the  
Guadalupe-Lompoc Initiative Project**

**WHEREAS**, the Regional Climate Collaboratives (RCC) grant program has been established by the State of California through Senate Bill 1072 to assist under-resourced communities in accessing funding for climate change mitigation and adaptation projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the Santa Barbara County Regional Climate Collaborative (Collaborative) was established to facilitate and implement equitable climate policies, programs, and projects that empower communities and improve quality of life within Santa Barbara County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Collaborative will apply for the RCC grant program to develop climate action-related plans, conduct community engagement activities, build local capacity, and foster collaborative networks within under-resourced communities throughout Santa Barbara County; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Lompoc (City) desires to be a co-applicant of the Collaborative's RCC grant application to create efficiencies and partnerships in local climate action-related project planning and implementation and use RCC grant funds to lead the development of a citywide water percolation site feasibility study as an element of the Guadalupe-Lompoc Initiative project proposed by the Collaborative.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute all required documents to apply for, and relating to, the RCC grant program, including, but not limited to, the Guadalupe-Lompoc Initiative Partnership Agreement and the Guadalupe-Lompoc Initiative Letter of Commitment.

**SECTION 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution is effective on the day of its adoption.
