**YOUTH SPORTS-** Youth Evolution Soccer had 42 participants and Youth Evolution Basketball had 18 for the month of May. There are 145 children signed up for Junior Giants.

**YOUTH & TEEN PROGRAMS-** Karate Tang Soo Do was offered the month of May with a total of 32 participants, Kendo had three participants. Registration for Summer Drop In opened on May 16<sup>th</sup>.

**ADULT CLASSES-** There were eight participants registered for Dance Fitness, three participants for Stretch and Relax and 13 participants for Adult Dance for the month of May.

**ADULT SPORTS-** There are 10 teams registered in the Coed Softball and nine teams in Men's. We had 28 participants for Drop-in Volleyball.

**LOMPOC OUTDOOR COMMUNITY MARKET-** 158 spaces were reserved for the month of May.

**SPECIAL EVENTS** – The return of the annual Mother Son Luau was a success, with over 200 couples attending the dances which was offered two evenings on May 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup>.
