

**LOMPOC RECREATION DIVISION**  
**STAFF REPORT**  
**July 2022**

**YOUTH SPORTS-** Youth Evolution Soccer had 35 participants, Youth Evolution Basketball had 29 participants, Youth Tennis had 11 participants, and 145 children are registered for Junior Giants for the month of July.

**YOUTH & TEEN PROGRAMS-** Karate Tang Soo Do was offered the month of July with a total of 29 participants, Kendo had five participants. Summer Drop In was held three weeks in July, with a total of 169 children registered. We offered five specialty interest camps: Kids Cooking Camps – 10, Canvas Kids – 13, Plant Camp – 10, Adventures in Stem LEGO Camp – 20, and Return of the Jedi Masters LEGO Camp – 12.

**ADULT CLASSES-** There five participants for Stretch and Relax, two participants for Yoga for the month of July.

**ADULT SPORTS-** There are eight teams registered in the Coed Softball and 12 teams in Men's. We had 28 participants for Drop-in Volleyball.

**LOMPOC OUTDOOR COMMUNITY MARKET-** 170 spaces were reserved for the month of July.

**SPECIAL EVENTS –** The first ever 4<sup>th</sup> of July Family Day at the Park was a huge success. The free admission event included live music, inflatables, games and food truck options. The celebration kicked off with a patriotic bike parade that began at the Veteran's Hall then made its way to Ryon Park. This year there was not a firework display as the pyro technician deemed Ryon Park an unsafe venue.

Movies in the Park was held two nights in July. On July 9<sup>th</sup> the movie aired was "Spiderman: No Way Home" and on July 23<sup>rd</sup> "Clifford – the Big Red Dog". The event was free and was held at Ryon Park.

**FACILITY RENTALS –**The Anderson Recreation Center had four rentals, five sports rentals, a Church rental that met 12 times; Dick DeWees Community and Senior Center had 10 rentals, Empty Bowls and one Church rental that met 11 times; 36 Park rentals. Lompoc Little League, Babe Ruth and Lompoc Girls Softball continued to use the sports fields for their games and practices. Old Town Market began Friday, July 15, 2022.

**MISCELLANEOUS PROGRAMS-** There were 176 passports that were processed at the Anderson Recreation Center this month and 142 Passport Photos processed.
