ADULT SPORTS LEAGUE- There were 9 teams registered in the Coed Softball and 12 teams in Men's.

ADULT CLASSES- There were 12 participants for Dance Fitness, 3 participants for Stretch and Relax and 15 for Adult Dance for the month of November.

SENIOR PROGRAMS and related services take place daily at the Dick DeWees Community & Senior Center (DDCSC) on a Monday through Friday basis, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. After 3:00 p.m. weekdays, and as available on weekends, the DDCSC is utilized for instructional classes, special events, meetings, and facility rentals. This month Strength Training had 70 participants and there was a Hi-Cap seminar offered.
