City Manager Dean Albro stated the lobby at City Hall will be closed to the public on November 16, 17, and 18, 2022; the Lompoc Electric Conservation division will be providing new LED holiday lights in exchange for old holiday lights at no cost to customers; and thanked the City Engineering Division for their work with Lompoc Valley Community Healthcare Organization (LVCHO) to secure a California Transportation Commission Active Transportation Program.
