**A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lompoc,
County of Santa Barbara, State of California,
Authorizing Application For, and Receipt of, Energy
Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant Program
Equipment Voucher for Efficient Lighting Equipment**

WHEREAS, the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA), also known as the Bipartisan Infrastructure Deal, was enacted by the 117th United States Congress and signed into law by President Joe Biden on November 15, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the IIJA includes an allocation of more than \$62 billion for the Department of Energy (DOE) to deliver a more equitable clean energy future for the American people; and

WHEREAS, \$550 million has been dedicated by the DOE to use towards administering grants and vouchers to eligible entities through the EECBG formula grant program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lompoc (City) is considered an eligible entity to apply for the EECBG program and has been allocated a formula grant award of \$76,480 in funding or an equipment voucher; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to apply for an equipment voucher from the DOE through the EECBG program to use towards energy efficient lighting equipment; and

WHEREAS, the use of an equipment voucher provided by the DOE for energy efficient equipment in municipally-owned facilities is an allowable use of the City's EECBG program allocation.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute all necessary documents related the application for an equipment voucher from the DOE through the EECBG program.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute all necessary documents related the receipt of an equipment voucher from the DOE through the EECBG program.

SECTION 3. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to use an equipment voucher provided by the DOE through the EECBG program toward allowable expenses related to energy efficient lighting equipment and installations.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution is effective on the day of its adoption.
