Recommendation: Council adopt Resolution No. 6565(23), which supersedes Resolution No. 6492(22), approving Terms and Conditions of an Internal Construction Loan Advancing Funds to the Solid Waste Fund for Interim Financing for Certain Capital Expenditures for Improvements to the Solid Waste Landfill; and adopt Resolution No. 6566(23) which will adopt the Plans and Special Provisions for Project No. FY-20-LF-1, Lompoc Landfill Drainage Improvements (Project), as required by Section 22039 of the Public Contract Code, award the construction contract (Contract) in the amount of \$5,489,550 to Bosco Constructors, Inc., in a form approved by the City Attorney, authorize the City Manager to execute the necessary agreements for the Contract, and authorizing the Solid Waste Superintendent, or designee, to approve additional construction costs and construction contract change orders in an amount not to exceed \$800,000, award the consulting contract for construction management, inspection, and construction materials testing services (Construction Management Contract) in the amount of \$603,410 to MNS Engineers, Inc., in a form approved by the City Attorney, authorize the City Manager to execute the necessary agreements for the Management Contract, authorize the Solid Superintendent, or designee, to approve additional costs and consulting contract change orders in an amount not to exceed \$80,000; and approve supplemental appropriations for the Project.
