- 2- 12-hour shifts per day
- 2 dispatcher on duty for each shift
- Dispatch Supervisor available during business hours (when fully staffed)
- 3 stations within the current dispatch center, only two have radios.

The Future

- The department has been planning to relocate the current dispatch center to the second floor in the station.
- The department will have 5 fully functional stations 1-Supervisor and 4 dispatchers.
- The department will be able to increase staffing (when budget allows) within dispatch which will allow the department to have Emergency Medical Dispatchers on duty 24-7.
- The cost of the additional radios is included in the current RFP.
- An updated center brings better dispatcher recruitment and retention.
