YOUTH SPORTS

We had 200 children participate in the Jr. Giants program and 30 for Youth Evolution Soccer Class and 15 for the Basketball Camp.

ADULT CLASSES

We had three participants in the Stretch and Relax class on Wednesday nights at the Dick DeWees Community Senior Center for July.

ADULT SPORTS

We had eight teams in Coed on Sundays at Thompson Park and 11 in the Men's League Thursdays at Ryon West and Thompson Park. Drop-in volleyball had 44 participants at the Anderson Rec Center every Tuesday night.

YOUTH & TEEN PROGRAMS- Karate Tang Soo Do was offered the month of July with a total of 31 participants, Kendo with eight participants, and Little Warriors with 12. Summer Drop In was held five weeks in July, with a total of 329 children registered. We offered five specialty interest camps: Kids Cooking Camps – 10, Canvas Kids – 6, Plant Camp – 8, and Fundamentals of Youth Boxing - 5.

SPECIAL EVENTS – The 4th of July Family Day at the Park was a huge success. The free admission event included live music, inflatables, games and food truck options. The celebration kicked off with a patriotic bike parade that began at the Veteran's Hall then made its way to Ryon Park.

There were 40 participants for the Golf Tournament held at Mission Club Golf Course on Friday, July 14th.

Movies in the Park was held on July 22nd. The movie aired was "Puss in Boots: The Last Wish". The event was free and was held at Ryon Park.

LOMPOC OUTDOOR COMMUNITY MARKET- 83 spaces were reserved for the month of July.

FACILITY RENTALS –The Anderson Recreation Center had four rentals, five sports rentals, a Church rental that met 12 times; Dick DeWees Community and Senior Center had 10 rentals, Empty Bowls and one Church rental that met 11 times; 36 Park rentals. Lompoc Little League, Babe Ruth and Lompoc Girls Softball continued to use the sports fields for their games and practices.
