

Grant Funds

Several state funding programs either require applicant jurisdictions to have a current certified Housing Element or prioritize funding for jurisdictions that have a current certified Housing Element.

City of Lompoc currently funded projects/programs that require certified Housing Element:

Senate Bill (SB) 2 (2017) \$160,000

Projects – Planning Zoning Code updates

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) \$500,000 annually

Projects – Beattie Park Playground, Pioneer Park Restrooms, Thompson Park improvements, Beattie Park Lighting, JM Park Concession/Restrooms

Home Investments Partnerships (HOME) \$110,000 annually (through Consortium)

Projects – Tenant Based Rental Assistance, Cypress Court Apartments

Local Early Action Planning Grant (LEAP) \$150,000

Regional Early Action Planning Grant (REAP) 1.0 \$151,152 (in process)

California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) Sustainable Transportation Planning Grant \$258,500

Project – Multi-modal Streetscape Plan
