

LOMPOC RECREATION DIVISION STAFF REPORT

November 2023

YOUTH SPORTS - Practices continued during the week at the Anderson Rec and LVMS gyms for the 350 children signed up for the Youth Basketball League and we had 18 children participate in Youth Evolution Soccer at River Park on Tuesdays. We had approximately 600 people attend the Youth Basketball opening ceremonies held Saturday, November 18 at the LVMS gym.

ADULT CLASSES - 15 people were enrolled for Dance Fitness held Mondays and Wednesdays at the Dewees Center and 8 people for the social dance class held Wednesdays at Dewees. 3 people participated in Stretch and Relax also held Wednesdays.

ADULT SPORTS - We had 8 teams in the Coed League Sundays at Thompson Park and 10 teams in the Men's League Thursdays at Ryon West and Thompson Park. Drop-in volleyball occurred Sunday nights at the Rec gym with around 30 participants.

YOUTH & TEEN PROGRAMS- Karate Tang Soo Do was offered the month of November with a total of 52 participants, Kendo was held with three participants, and a new Thanksgiving Break Kids Camp was offered with 19 participants.

LOMPOC OUTDOOR COMMUNITY MARKET- 39 spaces were reserved for the month of November.

SPECIAL EVENTS- We had 9 youth runners in the Turkey Dash and 16 adult runners for the Turkey Trot held at River Park on Sunday, November 19.

FACILITY RENTALS –The Anderson Recreation Center had a PE class that met 17 times, and 1 sports rental. The Dick DeWees Community and Senior Center held 2 private rentals, 3 meeting rentals and 2 church rentals that met 8 times total. Parks had 22 picnic rentals and 12 sports bookings.

MISCELLANEOUS PROGRAMS- There were 73 passports that were processed at the Anderson Recreation Center this month and 72 Passport Photos processed.
