

LOMPOC RECREATION DIVISION STAFF REPORT

December 2023

YOUTH SPORTS - Practice and games continued during the month at the Anderson Rec and LVMS gyms for the 350 children signed up for the Youth Basketball League and we had 6 children signed up for Youth Evolution Soccer at River Park on Tuesdays.

ADULT SPORTS - Drop-in volleyball had around 30 participants for the 2 Sundays it ran at the Anderson Rec Center.

YOUTH & TEEN PROGRAMS- Karate Tang Soo Do was offered the month of December with a total of 49 participants; Kendo was offered with three participants and Kids Winter Camp was offered with 27 participants. Santa Visits was full with eight bookings over the course of two nights in December.

LOMPOC OUTDOOR COMMUNITY MARKET- 41 spaces were reserved for the month of December.

SPECIAL EVENTS- The Lompoc Valley Children's Christmas Season Parade was a success with 70 entries and over 1500 participants. Santa Claus was available afterwards at Centennial Park to visit with the children. Hot cocoa and cookies were provided by the Lompoc Valley Chamber of Commerce and Lompoc Foursquare Church. The morning after, Breakfast with Santa was held at the Dick DeWees Center for two sessions, serving 150 participants.

FACILITY RENTALS –The Anderson Recreation Center had 1 private event rental, a PE class that met 16 times, 1 sports rental that booked 5 times. The Dick DeWees Community and Senior Center held 5 private rentals and 2 church rentals that met 6 times total. The Civic Auditorium had 5 special event rentals. Parks had 8 picnic rentals and 10 sports bookings.

MISCELLANEOUS PROGRAMS- There were 64 passports that were processed at the Anderson Recreation Center this month and 65 Passport Photos processed.
