ADULT CLASSES- Dance Fitness had 13 participants Monday and Wednesday nights at the DeWees Center and Cha Cha Dance Class had nine and Stretch and Relax had three participants on Wednesday nights.

YOUTH SPORTS - Practices continued during the week at the Anderson Rec and LVMS gyms for the four 3rd-6th grade all-star teams in the Youth Basketball League. We had 17 children in volleyball 9 to 12 years old , five in 13 to 17 year old group and 10 in Futsal soccer held at the Anderson Rec Center Sunday mornings. There were eight children signed up for Youth evolution soccer held Tuesdays at River Bend Park.

ADULT SPORTS - Drop-in volleyball continued Sundays with about 20 participants at the Anderson Rec Center.

YOUTH PROGRAMS- Karate Tang Soo Do was offered the month of February with a total of 53 participants; Kendo was offered with four.

LOMPOC OUTDOOR COMMUNITY MARKET- 21 spaces were reserved for the month of February.

SPECIAL EVENTS- This month was the Annual Father Daughter Dance that was sold out on Friday, Saturday and Sunday night over the weekend of February 2nd - February 4th at the Anderson Recreation Center. The event had over 330 girls and their dates over the course of the weekend.

We held the closing ceremonies February 13 and 15 at the Anderson Rec Center. There were over 300 people in attendance each night.

YOUTH COMMISSION- Lompoc Youth Commission held their annual TOTAL Teen Conference. The conference was held on Monday, February 12th at the Dick DeWees Community & Senior Center. Twenty-five teens spent their school day off listening to motivational speakers and members of the community in classes such as Putting Your Best Foot Forward & The Great Balancing Act. This year's event was co-sponsored by the Lompoc Unified School District.

FACILITY RENTALS –The Anderson Recreation Center had one sports rental that went Monday through Friday (Lompoc Unified School District) and five other sport rentals. three facility rentals. Dick DeWees Community and Senior Center had twelve rentals with one church rental that met nine times. City of Lompoc Human Resources twice. AARP Taxes eight times Mondays & Fridays and one Saturday.
