

LOMPOC RECREATION DIVISION STAFF REPORT

March 2024

ADULT CLASSES- Dance Fitness had 14 participants Monday and Wednesday nights at the DeWees Center and Waltz Dance Class had seven and Stretch and Relax had three participants on Wednesday nights.

YOUTH SPORTS - We had 17 children in volleyball 9 to 12 years old , 5 in 13 to 17 and 10 in Futsal soccer held at the Anderson Rec Center Sunday mornings. There were 8 children signed up for Youth Evolution Soccer held Tuesdays at River Bend Park. There were also 11 children signed up for Pickleball class held Sunday mornings at the Anderson Rec Center.

ADULT SPORTS - There were 9 teams in Men's softball played Thursdays at Thompson and Ryon Park and 9 teams in coed on Sundays at Thompson Park. Drop-in volleyball continued Sundays with around 20 participants at the Anderson Rec Center.

YOUTH PROGRAMS- Karate Tang Soo Do (four classes total) was offered the month of March with a total of 56 participants; Kendo was offered with six participants. An Easter Egg Deco workshop was held on Friday, March 29 with 12 students registered.

LOMPOC OUTDOOR COMMUNITY MARKET- We had vendors reserving 40 spaces for this past month at the Outdoor Community Market on Saturdays at the downtown parking lot. We did cancel 2 weekends due to rain.

SPECIAL EVENTS- The annual Lompoc Kiwanis and Parks & Recreation Easter Egg Hunt was offered this year indoors due to the weather. The event was held at the Dick DeWees Community & Senior Center and had over 1,000 patrons attend the event. The event was modified to include free face painting courtesy of MOMS Club, giveaways by Lompoc Walmart, egg hunts, kids arts and crafts, and a photo opportunity provided with the Easter Bunny.

The annual Youth Basketball Tournament took place March 2nd at the LVMS gym with four teams and approximately 200 people in attendance.

YOUTH COMMISSION- Lompoc Youth Commission had their joint Lompoc City Council meeting on Tuesday, March 19, 2024 at 6pm.

FACILITY RENTALS –The Anderson Recreation Center had one sports rental that went Monday through Friday (Lompoc Unified School District), four other sport rentals, one facility rental and Special Olympics three-times. Dick DeWees Community and Senior Center had nine rentals. There were two at no charge functions American Red Cross training and Santa Barbara County Elections once for training and once on election day. One church rental that met eleven times. City of Lompoc Human Resources once. AARP Taxes ten times Mondays & Fridays. Civic Auditorium had zero rentals only Lompoc Valley Middle School. There were thirty park rentals & nine sports rentals at the parks for the month of March.
