Chair Osborne announced Foundation Member Susan Gallacher has resigned from the Foundation and the Lompoc Beautification and Appearance Commission will vote another member from that Commission to serve on the Foundation and the Public Safety Commission will also vote to have a member serve on the Foundation; those votes will be held separately at future meetings of those individual Commissions. Ms. Osborne also announced the City Council approved the request from the Foundation for a donation of \$2,500 to be used for setup funding for the Foundation.
