On March 22, 2024, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) received notification from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security/FEMA that your EHP/NEPA request has been reviewed and approved for the following:

Installation of fencing and gates located at Lompoc Police Dept., 100 block South E Street, Lompoc, CA 93436. Estimated cost: \$272,000.
