

# **LOMPOC RECREATION DIVISION STAFF REPORT**

## **June 2024**

**YOUTH SPORTS-**There were 27 students signed up for Youth tennis Lessons held at Ryon Park, 17 children signed up for Youth Evolution Soccer Camp at River Bend Park and 10 for Youth Evolution Basketball camp at the Anderson Rec Center. We also have 180 participants in the Junior Giants baseball program.

**ADULT CLASSES-**Dance Fitness had 14 participants Monday and Wednesday nights and Stretch and Relax 3 and West Coast Swing Dance 8 Wednesdays at the DeWees Center.

**ADULT SPORTS-**Drop-in volleyball continues Thursdays with around 20 participants at the Anderson Rec Center. We have 9 Men's adult softball teams on Thursday at Ryon and Thompson Parks and 8 Coed teams on Sunday at Thompson Park.

**YOUTH & TEEN PROGRAMS-** Karate Tang Soo Do was offered the month of June with a total of 71 participants, Kendo had four participants. Summer Drop In began for the summer, with 50 children registered for the first two weeks. Kids Cooking Camp had 10 registrants, and a Dance Camp had 12. Youth Boxing was offered with 17 participants. Junior Police Camp was offered in collaboration with the Lompoc Police Department. The camp had 15 campers registered over the course of a 3-day camp. Interviews for the Volunteen program for youth ages 13-15 were conducted, with five being selected for the summer.

**SPECIAL EVENTS –** The first of summer Movies in the Park was held on Sat. June 29<sup>th</sup> at Ryon Park. The free event had 150 citizens attend to enjoy the movie aired, "Kung Fu Panda 4".

**LOMPOC OUTDOOR COMMUNITY MARKET-** We had vendors make 49 reservations last month at the Outdoor Community Market on Saturdays at the downtown parking lot.

**FACILITY RENTALS –** The Anderson Recreation Center had eight sports rentals and two private event rentals. Civic Auditorium had two rentals. There were 52 park rentals & four sports rentals at the parks.

**MISCELLANEOUS PROGRAMS-** There were 104 passports that were processed at the Anderson Recreation Center this month and 94 Passport Photos processed.
