**ADULT CLASSES-** Dance Fitness had 12 participants Monday and Wednesday nights and Stretch and Relax had 3 and Adult Social Dance had 6 Wednesdays at the DeWees Center.

**YOUTH SPORTS -** There were three children signed up for Youth Futsal Tuesday and nine for Youth Volleyball on Wednesdays at the Anderson Rec Center. We also had 180 signups for the Junior Giants baseball program.

**ADULT SPORTS -** Drop-in volleyball continues Thursdays with around 20 participants at the Anderson Rec Center. We have nine coed teams on Sundays at Thompson Park and 11 men's teams Thursdays at Ryon and Thompson parks.

**YOUTH PROGRAMS-** Karate Tang Soo Do (four classes total) was offered in the month of May with a total of 58 participants; Kendo was offered with four participants.

**LOMPOC OUTDOOR COMMUNITY MARKET-** Vendors made 34 reservations at the Outdoor Community Market on Saturdays at the downtown parking lot.

**SPECIAL EVENTS-** The Senior Expo was held on May 3<sup>rd</sup> at the Dick DeWees Center which had 64 vendors and 520 people in attendance.
