

LOMPOC RECREATION DIVISION STAFF REPORT

July 2024

YOUTH SPORTS-There were 27 children signed up for Youth Tennis Lessons held at the Ryon Parks tennis courts and 38 for Youth Evolution Soccer held Tuesdays at River Bend Park. There were also 9 children attending Youth volleyball class on Sundays at the Anderson Rec Center gym. We also had 180 participants in the Junior Giants baseball program at Ryon, Thompson, and Beattie Parks.

ADULT CLASSES-Dance Fitness had 13 participants Monday and Wednesday nights and Stretch and Relax had 4 Wednesday at the DeWees Center.

ADULT SPORTS-Drop-in volleyball continued Thursdays with around 20 participants at the Anderson Rec Center. We had 9 Men's adult softball teams on Thursday at Ryon and Thompson Parks and 8 Coed teams on Sunday at Thompson Park.

YOUTH & TEEN PROGRAMS- Karate Tang Soo Do was offered the month of July with a total of 64 participants, Kendo with two participants. Summer Drop In was held five weeks in July, with a total of 262 registrations. We offered five specialty interest camps: Kids Cooking Camp – 10, Canvas Kids – 19, Plant Camp – 9, and Jr. Firefighters Camp - 36.

SPECIAL EVENTS – The 4th of July Family Day at the Park was a huge success. The free admission event included live music, inflatables, games and food truck options. The celebration kicked off with a patriotic bike parade that began at the Veteran's Hall then made its way to Ryon Park.

Movies in the Park was held on July 20th. The movie aired was "Ghostbusters: Frozen Empire". The event was free and was held at Ryon Park.

The annual Skateboard Competition was held Saturday, July 13 at the Skateboard Park at College Park with 8 contestants.

LOMPOC OUTDOOR COMMUNITY MARKET- We had 29 space reservations for the month at the Outdoor Community Market on Saturdays at the downtown parking lot.

FACILITY RENTALS – The Anderson Recreation Center had six sports rentals and two facility rentals. Dick DeWees Community and Senior Center had eleven rentals with one church rental that met seven times. Empty Bowls had their event set up on Tuesday and the event on Wednesday Civic Auditorium had no rentals. There were thirty-nine park rentals & five sports rentals at the parks for the month of July.
