- **WHEREAS**, AHC administers the Program for college students in the Lompoc region; and
- **WHEREAS**, AHC needs additional volunteer community service opportunities for students in Lompoc for the 2024-2025 academic year; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City has identified volunteer community service opportunities fitting for the Program; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to participate in the Program as a Community Host Organization (CHO) by offering volunteer community service opportunities to local college students.
- NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:
- **SECTION 1.** The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized and directed to cause the City to participate as a CHO in the Program offered by AHC.
- **SECTION 2.** The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute all documents necessary for the City to participate in the Program, including, but not limited to, a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and Site Supervisor Agreement.
