October 2024

YOUTH SPORTS - We had 10 children signed up for Youth volleyball held Wednesdays at the Anderson Rec Center and 9 children signed up for tennis lessons held Tuesdays and Thursdays at Ryon Park and 17 children signed up for Youth Evolution Soccer held Tuesdays and Saturdays at River Bend Park. We also had 9 children signed up for Youth Evolution basketball Fridays at the Anderson Rec Center gym along with 359 children signed up for the Youth Basketball League.

ADULT CLASSES - Dance Fitness had 13 participants at the DeWees Center.

ADULT SPORTS - Drop-in volleyball continues Thursdays with around 20 participants at the Anderson Rec Center. We had 9 Men's adult softball teams on Wednesday and Thursday and 10 Coed teams Sunday at Thompson Park.

YOUTH & TEEN PROGRAMS- Karate Tang Soo Do was offered the month of October with a total of 60 participants, Kendo was offered with three participants.

LOMPOC OUTDOOR COMMUNITY MARKET- We had 19 vendor space reservations for the Outdoor Community Market on Saturdays at the downtown parking lot.

SPECIAL EVENTS- The annual Dunkin' for Pumpkins was held at the Lompoc Aquatic Center on Sunday, October 27. The event had over 140 participants attend the floating pumpkin patch and paint workshop.

FACILITY RENTALS-The Anderson Recreation Center had 29 sports rentals, Dick DeWees Community and Senior Center had 13, and the Civic Auditorium had 3 rentals that met 37 times. There were 30 park rentals & 26 sports rentals at the parks for the month of October.
