

**RESOLUTION NO. 6720(24)**

**A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lompoc,  
County of Santa Barbara, State of California,  
Authorizing Supplemental Appropriations for a Police  
Department Renovation and Expansion Study**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Lompoc’s (City) Police Department building was constructed in 1986 when the population of Lompoc was 27,739 and the Lompoc spanned 7 square miles; and

**WHEREAS**, since 1986 Lompoc’s population as of the last census in 2024 is 43,834, and Lompoc spans 11.64 square miles; and

**WHEREAS**, Lompoc’s growth has resulted in the growth of the Police Department, which requires more space to accommodate departmental needs for additional staff that has been added since 1986 as well as the projection of future staffing; and

**WHEREAS**, a study is required to ascertain the feasibility of adding 10,000 square feet to the rear of the current building; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to take the necessary steps to ensure there is adequate funding for obtaining the study.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** To approve budget appropriations for a study to evaluate the feasibility of expanding the Lompoc Police Department by an additional 10,000 square feet.
