LOMPOC RECREATION DIVISION STAFF REPORT September 2018

ADULT CLASSES – 6 adult classes were held during the month of September with 46 participants.

ADULT SPORTS - We had Coed Adult Softball competing on Sundays with 380 participants and Men's League on Wednesday and Thursday with 175 participants.

FACILITY RENTALS - There were a total of 47 Park rentals this month, 13 rentals at the Anderson Recreation Center, 18 rentals at the Dick DeWees Community and Senior Center, and the Lompoc Unified School District was at the Civic Auditorium.

SENIOR PROGRAMS - and related services take place daily at the Dick DeWees Community & Senior Center (DDCSC) on a Monday through Friday basis, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. After 3:00 p.m. weekdays, and as available on weekends, the DDCSC is utilized for instructional classes, special events, meetings, and facility rentals. There was a 3 day Bridge Tournament with around 250 participants.

YOUTH CLASSES/PROGRAMS- There were six youth and teen programs offered, totaling 58 participants. Programs offered were archery, cooking camp, and martial arts.

YOUTH SPORTS – The Kidz Love Soccer Program had 47 children signed up. The Youth Basketball Program has over 175 children enrolled thus far.

MISCELLANEOUS PROGRAMS - There were 126 passports that were processed at the Anderson Recreation Center this month and 104 Passport Photos processed.

SPECIAL EVENTS- We had over 80 participants attend the first ever Family Dance Party. The event was themed "Totally 80's" and was held on Friday, September 28th from 6pm-8:30pm. Participants got to compete for "Best Dressed" and also in limbo, all while dancing to 80's tunes.

VEHICLE RENATLS - We had 3 vehicle rentals for private party excursions this month.

Lap Swimming – Monday thru Sunday, times vary.

Recreational Swim Schedule – Saturday and Sunday from 1:00 to 3:00PM.

Swim Lessons: Monday/Wednesday Session began on Monday, September 3rd; Tuesday/Thursday Session began Tuesday, September 4th.

- Both Lompoc and Cabrillo Boys' Water Polo teams began practicing and playing games during the week.
- Next month we will begin working with the Lompoc School District for the return of their 3rd grade Learn to Swim Program.
