

Storm Water Program

Business Inspection Fees



- In October of 2008 the Central Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board placed the City of Lompoc under Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) permit.
 - The terms of this permit required inspection of commercial and industrial businesses to identify sources of potential storm water pollution.
- In July 2013, the State Water Resources Control Board included a statewide requirement to inspect businesses in its revised 2013 Phase II MS4 permit.
 - Funding to conduct this activity was not provided by the state.
- The City of Lompoc has begun a business inspection program, in compliance with state MS4 permit requirements. To recoup a portion of the cost of this program, the City Council adopted a \$110.00 fee for each business inspection in its Master Fee Schedule, which became effective on March 5, 2016.
