STAFF REPORT  
October 2018**

**ADULT CLASSES** – 4 adult classes were held during the month of October with 43 participants.

**ADULT SPORTS** - We had Coed Adult Softball competing on Sundays with 380 participants and Men's League on Wednesday and Thursday with 175 participants.

**FACILITY RENTALS** - There were a total of 40 Park rentals this month, 17 rentals at the Anderson Recreation Center, 20 rentals at the Dick DeWees Community and Senior Center, and the Lompoc Unified School District was at the Civic Auditorium.

**SENIOR PROGRAMS** - and related services take place daily at the Dick DeWees Community & Senior Center (DDCSC) on a Monday through Friday basis, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. After 3:00 p.m. weekdays, and as available on weekends, the DDCSC is utilized for instructional classes, special events, meetings, and facility rentals. Senior programs continued for the month of October, to include Strength Training, Fit 101 and the Mac Users Group.

**YOUTH CLASSES/PROGRAMS**- There were six youth and teen programs offered, totaling 55 participants. Programs offered were a painting and pumpkin deco workshops and martial arts.

**YOUTH SPORTS** – The Youth Basketball Program has over 220 children enrolled this year. We held a basketball skills night on October 17<sup>th</sup> at LVMS that had 60 children and 120 spectators show up.

**MISCELLANEOUS PROGRAMS** - There were 165 passports that were processed at the Anderson Recreation Center this month and 175 Passport Photos processed.

**EXCURSIONS** – We held a trip to the Huntington Library and Gardens on October 13<sup>th</sup> for 10 people.

**VEHICLE RENTALS** - We had 2 vehicle rentals for private party excursions this month
