Ynez Riverbed

Recommendation:

Staff recommends the City Council review, receive and file, this staff report regarding the need for continuing the local emergency proclaimed by the City Council on October 2, 2018, relating to the clean-up of the Santa Ynez riverbed (Riverbed).

Background and Discussion:

On October 2, 2018, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 6220(18) proclaiming a local emergency relating to the clean-up of the Riverbed.

Government Code section 8630(c) requires the City Council to review the need for continuing the local emergency at least once every 30 days until the City Council terminates the local emergency.

The City Council undertook the first review at the October 16, 2018, City Council meeting.

The City Council undertook a second review on or before November 15, 2018.

As of today, there is a need to continue the local emergency because the conditions described in the October 2, 2018, City Council staff report and in Resolution No. 6220(18) continue to exist.

Significant amounts of trash, refuse and infectious waste still exist in the Riverbed and continue to pose significant risks to surface water quality and potentially to groundwater and drinking water quality. Additionally, significant dangers still exist related to excavations of the river's bank by the former Riverbed inhabitants, which have potentially compromised the bank's integrity and increased the risk of flow and flood-

related damage to the bank, the City's bike path, and the roadway beyond. Clean-up of the homeless encampments is also necessary to discourage re-inhabitation of these areas and associated crime.

Mitigation and clean-up of these conditions continue to require assistance from the Federal, State and/or other local entities. A source for funding the clean-up of the Riverbed still has not been identified. It is crucial for this work to take place prior to the impending rainy season when flows occur in the river, giving rise to the potential for flow and flood-related damage to the banks and mobilizing pollutants in the Riverbed.

Fiscal Impact:

The continuation of the declaration of a local emergency by the City Council does not have a material fiscal impact on the City or the City's General Fund.

Conclusion:

For the above reasons, there is a need to continue the local emergency proclaimed by the City Council in Resolution No. 6220(18) on October 2, 2018.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends the City Council adopt Resolution No. 6230(18) (attached), which recites the facts and declares the results of the Consolidated General Election held on November 6, 2018, as provided by the County Clerk-Recorder-Assessor and Registrar of Voters Certification of Election Results of the Official Canvass.

Discussion:

As noted in Exhibit A of Resolution No. 6230(18), the County Clerk has canvassed the returns of the election and provided the City with an official Certification of Election Results of the Official Canvass and Certified Results. The City Council is requested to adopt a resolution reciting the results as determined by the Election:

- Jenelle Osborne was elected as Mayor for the full term of two years;
- Victor Vega was elected as City Council Member from District 2 for the full term of four years; and
- Dirk Starbuck was elected as City Council Member from District 3 for the full term of four years.

Fiscal Impact:

Earlier in the year, the City took the appropriate steps to consolidate the election for Mayor and City Council Members from Districts 2 and 3 with the General Election. This action minimized the cost to the City of the election to be reimbursed to Santa Barbara County consistent with past elections. The City budgeted approximately \$18,000 in the Biennial Budget Fiscal Years (Budget) 2017-2019 for election costs. While Santa Barbara County will not invoice the City for the November 6, 2018, election immediately,

the prior election reimbursement cost was \$19,097.16 for the November 2016 election cycle to provide context for the cost of the most recent election.

While these costs were authorized with the Budget 2017-2019 and affirmed with the actions to consolidate the City's election with the County's process, the action to certify the election does not have a fiscal impact other than the time to create this staff report, the related resolution and the time to present this item.

Conclusion:

Before the City Clerk may issue the Certificates of Election and administer the Oaths of Office, the City Council must adopt Resolution No. 6230(18), declaring the results of the Consolidated General Election.

A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lompoc, County of Santa Barbara, State of California, In the Matter of Reciting the Facts of the Consolidated General Election Held in Lompoc on November 6, 2018, Declaring the Result Thereof, and Other Matters as Provided by Law

WHEREAS, a Consolidated General Election was held and conducted in the City of Lompoc (City), California, on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, as required by law (Election); and

WHEREAS, notice of the Election was given in time, form, and manner as provided by law; and voting precincts were properly established; election officers were appointed; in all respects the Election was held and conducted, the votes were cast, received, and canvassed, and the returns made and declared in time, form, and manner as required by the provisions of the California Elections Code for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, the County Clerk has canvassed the returns of the Election and provided the City with an Official Certification of Election Results of the Official Canvass and Certified Results, attached hereto as Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. There were seventeen precincts established for the purpose of holding the Consolidated General Election.

SECTION 2. The Election was held for the purposes of electing the following officers of the City as required by applicable laws:

A Mayor of the City of Lompoc for a full term of two years; and Two members of the City Council for full terms of four years.

SECTION 3. The names of candidates for Mayor at the Election were as follows:

James Mosby Jenelle Osborne

SECTION 4. The names of candidates at the Election for Member of the City Council of the City of Lompoc were as follows:

<u>District 2:</u> Victor Vega Shirley Sherman

SECTION 5. The number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City to each of the above-named candidates were as listed in attached Exhibit "A."

SECTION 6. The City Council hereby determines and declares, as a result of the election:

Jenelle Osborne was elected as Mayor of the City of Lompoc for a full term of two years;

Victor Vega was elected as Member of the City Council of the City of Lompoc for District 2 for a full term of four years; and

Dirk Starbuck was elected as Member of the City Council of the City of Lompoc for District 3 for a full term of four years.

SECTION 7. The City Clerk shall enter in the records of the City Council of the City of Lompoc a statement of the Election results, showing:

- 1. The whole number of votes cast in the City;
- 2. The names of the candidates;
- 3. Each office sought by the candidates;
- 4. The number of votes given at each precinct to each candidate; and
- 5. The number of votes given in the City to each candidate.

SECTION 8. The City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and duly authenticated; the City Clerk shall administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have such persons subscribe thereto and file the same in the Office of the City Clerk; whereupon, each and all of the persons duly elected shall be inducted into the respective offices to which they have been elected.

SECTION 9. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions and shall note its passage in the minutes of the proceedings of the City Council meeting at which the resolution is passed and adopted.

SUBJECT: Council Discussion and Possible Action on Process to Fill the Mid-Term

Council Vacancy

Recommendation:

Staff recommends the City Council consider and discuss the options available to fill the remaining term for the Council seat vacated by the Mayor-elect, and provide direction as Council deems appropriate.

Background:

The official certified results of the November 6, 2018 election are expected to be received from the County on or before December 6, 2018. Based on current unofficial results, it is anticipated Councilmember Osborne will be elected Mayor. Assuming that is the case, Councilmember Osborne's unexpired term as a Councilmember will be vacated when she is sworn in as Mayor.

Discussion:

Within 60 days after a vacancy occurs (which in this case is February 4, 2019), the City Council must fill the vacancy by either (1) appointing a qualified resident to fill the vacancy or (2) calling a special election. (Government Code Section 36512.)

In either case, the newly appointed or elected councilmember will serve out the remainder of Councilmember Osborne's term, which ends in December 2020.

The new councilmember can reside in any district because he or she will fill the vacancy in Councilmember Osborne's current at-large seat, and therefore only needs to be qualified for an at-large seat. In the November 2020 election, however, that seat must be filled by a resident of District 1.

Special Election

If Council decides to fill the vacancy by a special election, the election must be held at the next regularly scheduled election date that is at least 114 days after Council makes that decision. Pursuant to Elections Code section 1000, that election date would be November 5, 2019. This nearly year-long delay is due to California having removed its June regular election date starting in 2019.

The person elected at that special election would serve only until December 2020. Staff has been informed by the County Elections Office that the County currently does not plan to hold any elections in 2019. If that remains true, the City would need to conduct the special election entirely on its own, which is extremely expensive. The City's cost of a special election consolidated with the County is also very expensive – estimated to be a minimum of \$150,000 based on County estimates.

Appointment

If Council decides to avoid the expense of holding a special election, then the method used to make an appointment is entirely within Council's discretion, as long as the appointment is made by February 4, 2019.

The City Council can make an appointment tonight or at any time prior to February 4. The Council can appoint any person it chooses, assuming the appointee meets the age, residency, and voter registration requirements and is willing to be appointed.

Application Process:

As an alternative, Council may wish to establish a process for receiving applications from individuals wishing to be appointed to the vacant City Council seat. For example, the Council may set an application period for candidates to submit an official City application with the City Clerk, with the intention of making an appointment at a future Council meeting after consideration of the applications. A sample application will be brought forth for the December 18th Council meeting for discussion and approval.

If Council wishes to fill the vacancy as soon as possible under this method, then it is recommended Council immediately approve an application form and establish the application period (for example: December 7, 2018 through December 14, 2018), and the

applications could be considered and possibly acted upon at the December 18, 2018 regular Council meeting or any special meeting that same week.

A longer, and perhaps more inclusive process would be the following:

- 1. Dec. 6, 2018 establish that an appointment will be made by Council
- 2. Dec. 7 to Dec. 11 Council members create one question each, which would then be reviewed by City Attorney to ensure appropriate language, etc.
- 3. Dec. 12 Dec. 14 Staff creates and finishes the proposed application form
- 4. Dec. 18 Council to approve the application form. Form will be placed on the City's website, as well as printed copies available at the City Hall and Library.
- 5. Dec. 18 to Dec. 31 open period for public to submit applications. All applications need to be dropped off/received via mail (postmarked), by Dec. 31, 2019.
- 6. Jan. 2 to Jan. 4 Council reviews the submissions
- 7. Jan. 8 2019 Council holds special session to interview candidates and make selection and possible appointment.

This process, though longer, does take in account that many people and families that are busy with Holiday events and may not have time to consider becoming part of local City government in a shortened application process. It would allow the public time to consider if they would have the ability to meet the time commitments for the position.

This process is just an example. The Council can choose any process it wishes to appoint the new Councilmember.

Selection Process:

Another decision the Council must make is what process will be used to select an appointee after the interviews of candidates. Any voting system may be used, as long as each Councilmember's votes are displayed or announced on the record. The voting system can be decided on tonight or at any later meeting prior to the interview date.

Just as examples, the Council could choose a simple "nomination and vote" process like used for appointments to City commissions and committees, or a more complex process of elimination of the candidates using several rounds of voting (perhaps where each Councilmember has two or three votes to allocate among the candidates as they choose in each voting round). The final decision will be up to the Council majority.

Fiscal Impact:

The fiscal impact for making an appointment is negligible. The fiscal impact of conducting a special election is estimated to be a minimum of \$150,000.
